NOTIFICATION

No. SO(CD)6/56/83. In exercise of the Powers conferred on him under Civil Defence (Special Powers) Rules, 1951 read with Appendix-III regarding Delegation of Powers to the Provincial Governments vide Notification No.5/1/50-CDI, dated 26.7.1951 and under the Punjab Government Rules of Business-1974, the Governor of the Punjab is pleased to specify the Mission and Functions of the Civil Defence Department Punjab, as under:-

- 1- Render advice on civil defence and fire service matters to public and private sectors.
- 2- Plan and co-ordinate Civil Defence Schemes in classified towns as per Report of the Civil Defence Committee on Defence Planning or as per instructions issued by the Federal/Provincial Governments.
- 3- Liaise with the Armed Forces for Fortress and Air Defence on matters relating to Civil Defence.
- 4- Impart basic civil defence, first aid, rescue and fire training to general public, industrial/commercial concerns, government departments and educational institutions.
- 5- Specify, co-ordinate and enforce fire protection and civil defence measures in industrial and commercial concerns and in other premises considered essential.
- 6- Inspect Municipal Fire Brigades and Fire Protection Measures in industrial/commercial concerns etc.
- 7- Hold Fire Coordinatory Exercises, Civil Defence Demonstrations and Seminars in all major towns of the Province.
- 8- Standardise fire appliances and civil defence equipment.
- 9- Issue instructions to urban councils and other agencies, in civil defence functions.
- 10- Assist government departments with available resources in peace and war emergencies.
- 11- Organise Warden Service in classified towns and train its volunteers for civil defence services.
- 12- Help local administration in peace and war emergencies through the Warden Service and its volunteers.
- 13- Render first aid and evacuate casualties during emergencies, if such resources are available.
- 14- Carry out publicity for mass education in Civil Defence.
- 15- Provide assistance, render advice and impart training in bomb detection and disposal.
- 16- Train Civil Defence staff in the functioning of Civil Defence Services.


